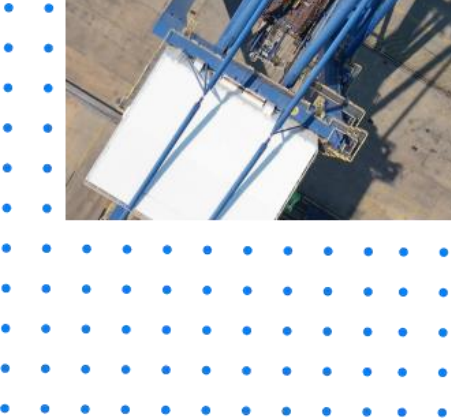
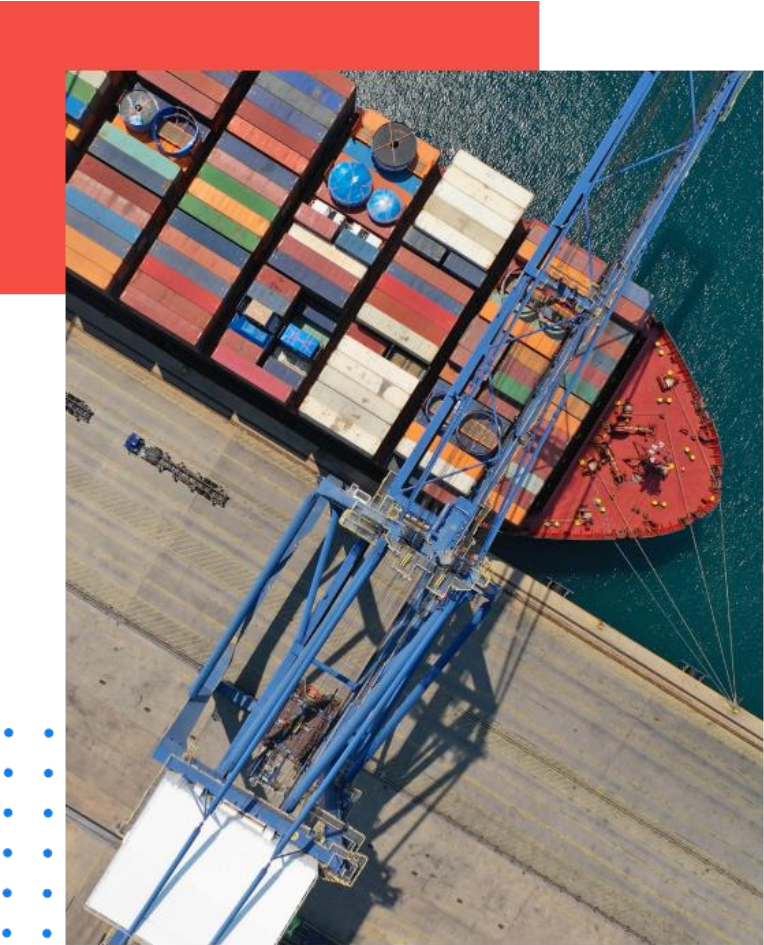

Quick FSVP Overview

What is the purpose of FSVP?



To prevent food safety hazards throughout the supply chain to protect U.S. consumers



Mandates U.S. importers assure all imported foods meet the same stringent food safety standards as those required for food products produced in the U.S.

Your shipment is subject to FSVP if you can answer **YES** to any of the questions below:

- ✓ Did you agree to purchase the product before it left a foreign country?
- ✓ Do you own it at the time of entry into the USA?
- ✓ Are you the ultimate consigner?
- ✓ Is this product imported for you and only your company?

Developing and Maintaining FSVP Compliance is Complex

What do FSVPs involve?



Collect food safety documents from your foreign suppliers (i.e. HACCP, process flowchart, labels, and product description)



Review food safety documents and determine if the process is compliant



Write the FSVP and note any corrective actions and state verification activities



Contact foreign supplier to address corrective actions and obtain verification activities



Approve the supplier

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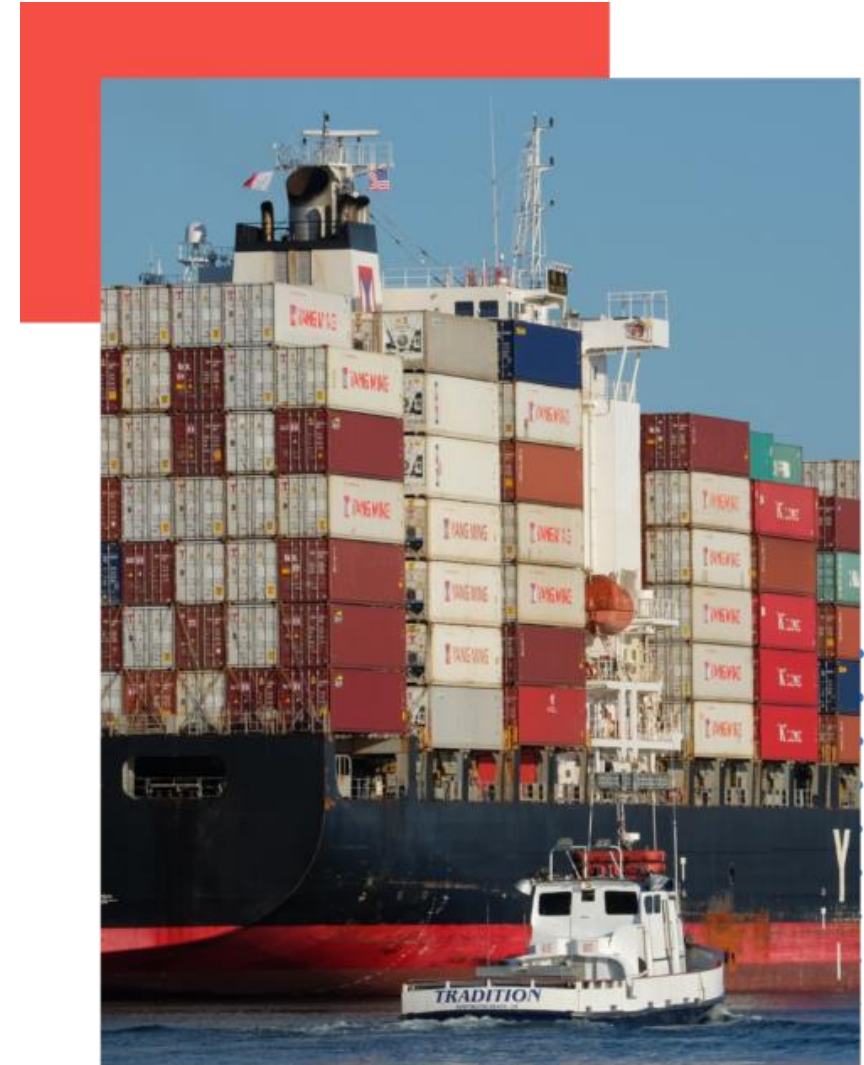

- FDA Facility Registration
- Proper, U.S. Compliant Label
- Established FSVP Agent/Importer
 - FCE, HACCP
- Product-Specific Regulations



Top 10 FSVP Best Practices

1

FSVP team obtains FSVP and PCQI training

2

Collect food safety documents sooner rather than later

3

Confirm who is the FSVP importer for each shipment (IOR is not the same)

4

Collect, review, and approve the FSVP

5

Monitor your DUNS number; know who is designating you as FSVP importer

6

Proactively investigate supplier noncompliance

7

Confirm that you are monitoring the correct supplier facility

8

Document your monitoring of your suppliers' FDA compliance status

9

Confirm third-party audits have the FSMA/FSVP module

10

Confirm two trained individuals have access to your FSVP

Risks of single sourcing:

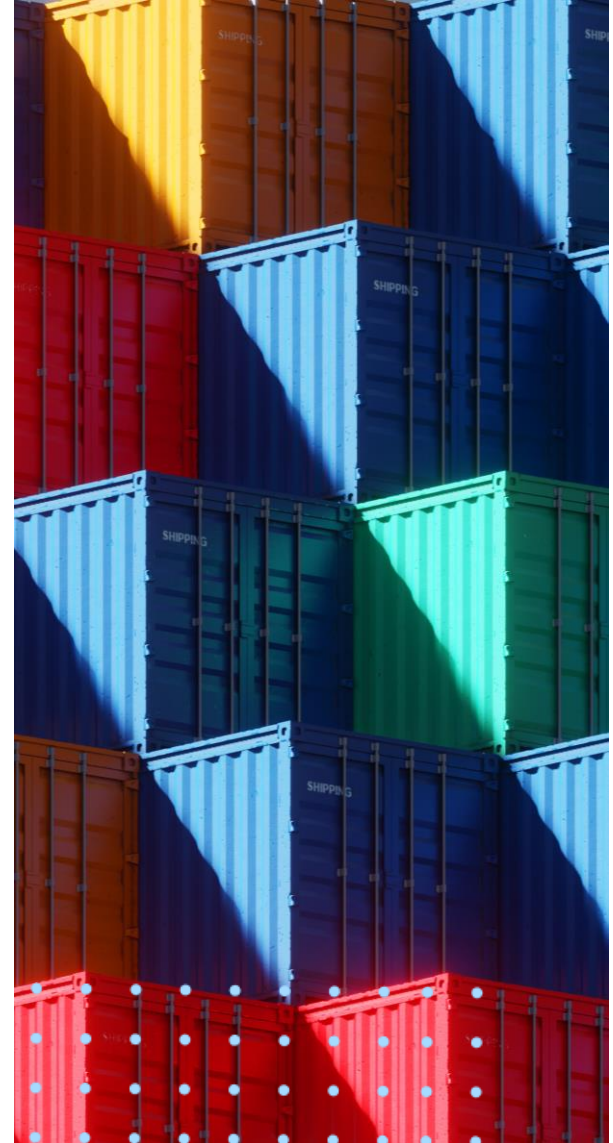
- Vendor increasing costs & impact to bottom line
